Registration for ICT Industry Resource Pool

BACKGROUND

ICT Industry Skills Council (ICTISC) is a ADB funded project under the Sector Skills Development Project (SSDP) of the Ministry of Skills Development and Vocational Training to create a synergy in the ICT industry and Tertiary and Vocational Education system in the country while creating national strategies and operational plans to make standardized skills requirements for various job roles in the ICT industry.

Consisting industry leaders and stakeholders, the ICT Skills Council is ICT Industry driven organization supported by the government of Sri Lanka. The ICT skills council aims to prepare Sri Lankan workforce for Digital Sri Lanka and make Sri Lanka an ICT skill hub for the global ICT industry and we are aligned with the government strategy of reaching a \$5 billion industry by 2022. Further, ICTISC functions as the platform between the IT Industry and the Vocational Education Sector of the country.

ICTISC is providing advisory service to the Tertiary and Vocational Education System in curriculum development, identifying industry demand and trends, training and development of Teachers in the education system etc. The prime objective is to utilize services of professionals who would like to act as a catalyst in getting these services for the ICT sector as a *professional trainers and consultants*.

Through the Resource Pool, ICTISC intends to utilize the capabilities of available ICT Professionals, Trainers and Consultants to address the training and consulting needs of the TVET Sector by offering services to increase productivity.

This scheme promotes a pool of professional's that are expert in **"Information Technology and Related Disciplines"** and can play a dynamic and proactive role as a **"Professional Trainer/Resource Person"**. With these qualified trainers in the pool, ICTISC aims to capitalize its wide industrial network and utilize the services of trainers who can act as change agents by exploiting their knowledge, know-how, competencies and proficiency practically in ICT Sector to deliver training sessions across the country and providing the advisory services in curriculum development.

ICT Industry Resource Pool under the supervision of ICTISC will serve as recognized platform for the trainers/consultants at national level for vocational and tertiary education system.

OBJECTIVES

1. The pool or register will represent professional from multiple backgrounds i.e. Software Development, Programming, thereby bringing people from diverse background at one place.
2. To help TVET Sector organizations in the selection of professional trainers.
3. To provide training & business opportunities to the professionals who intend to build their reputation in local and international market.
4. To strengthen the resources of the TVET Sector

CATEGORIES OF RESOURCE POOL

1. Trainers / Resource People

Suitably qualified ICT industry experts for the Industry Resource Pool to services for the TVET Sector in curriculum development, Training the Resource People, Conducting Awareness sessions etc.

1. A Degree with specialization in Information Technology related stream with 10 years Working Experience in the ICT Industry.

Or

2. A Master in the relevant field obtained at least 24 months durations (or equivalent part-time course of study) with a 5 years working experience in the ICT Industry.

Or

3. Professional qualifications or professional experience in Software Development/ Programming / Other relevant discipline for minimum 10 years with proven track records in an established organization.

2. Consultants

An individual who has got substantial experience of consultancy and qualifies to deliver consultancy projects and provide services. The core competencies should include skills related to ICT, Project Management and has experience of more than 10 consultancy projects.

CONDITIONS :

1. Candidates will be interviewed and evaluated by the ICT Industry Skills Council.
2. Board of Directors of the ICT Industry Skills Council and their family members cannot apply for the resource pool.
3. This is not a permanent position and the services can be rendered on assignment basis when a requirement comes.
4. Only individuals can apply for the Resource Pool on personal capacity.
5. No objection letter should be submitted from the employer before undertaking any assignment

HONORARIUM

1. Honorarium for Trainers/ Resource Persons

The trainers selected will be paid an honorarium as per the government approved criteria as per the category they fall.

2. Honorarium for Consultants

ICTISC intends to engage individual consultants or consulting organizations to assist in its consulting projects. In this regard, the fees shall be agreed on the basis of nature of project. The honorarium shall be dependent on the consulting project agreement signed between ICTISC and interested stakeholder.
